As your child transitions from K2 to Y1 at SJS, we would like to warmly invite you to a second transition afternoon on Wednesday 12th June from 3:30-5pm.

## Focus of the Experience

Parents will have the opportunity to participate in a workshop exploring more about the transition to and experience in Year 1 at SJS, take a full tour of the school, enjoy a variety of activities and socialise at a coffee afternoon. Whilst this is happening, your child will have the chance to explore the Early Years environment during a stay and play where the Y1 teachers will facilitate activities to engage and encourage interaction between the cohort.

This is not a compulsory transition experience, however, we encourage all parents and children to attend this important event and take advantage of the opportunity to connect with the school community.

## Logistics

Children should wear casual clothing that they are comfortable in as they will be engaged in a range of play experiences throughout the session.

Only TWO parents, strictly due to space, are able to attend with their child on that day.

Please note that there is no parking available for parents at the school, and space is limited in our drop-off bay. Via public transport, the nearest MTR stop is Sha Tin Station on the East Rail Line. From there, you may take the 69K Minibus from the Pai Tau Street Minibus Terminus. Families are then asked to queue outside the entrance to SJS on the pavement.

Sha Tin College buses will start departing from the campus at 3:30 pm at the end of their school day, which we anticipate will cause heavy foot and vehicle traffic around this time. To ensure that you arrive on campus in a timely and safe manner, we advise you to plan accordingly and arrive on campus no earlier than 3:20pm.
